Comment: Kathleen Mo Mhuirnín (Kathleen Mavourneen or My Beloved

Kathleen) is a song, written in 1837, composed by Frederick Crouch with lyrics by Marion Crawford. It was popular during the American Civil War. Mavourneen is a term of endearment derived from the Irish Gaelic mo mhuirnín, meaning my beloved. The Irish soprano Catherine Hayes (1818–1861), the Hibernian prima donna, was the first Irish woman to sing
